KHADI SCHEMES

Marketing Development Assistance (MDA)

Sale of Khadi (Cotton, Woollen, Silk) & Polyvastra produced in Gujarat is made through registered Khadi Institutes/Societies. Besides 20% M.D.A. (Marketing Development Assistance) declared by KVIC, 15% M.D.A. (5% to spinner, 5% to Weaver artisan as special package and 5% to the institute for production expenditure as M.D.A.) is also declared by the State Government.

KHADI-POLYVASTRA SPINNING SPECIAL WEAVING EQUIPMENT SCHEME:

According to the Rate fixed by the Khadi & Village Industries Commission (KVIC), charges of Hank paid on AANK on production of cotton and on kinds of weaving, weaving charge is paid in the State. Besides this by the State assistance given as below: -

- (A)Besides the fixed wage, Rs.3/- per Hank on production of Hank as a Special Spinning Assistance given by the State Government to all spinner and weaver artisans.
- (B) Besides the fixed wage, Rs.6/- per Sq.Mtr. Special Weaving Assistance and Rs.2/- Weaving Equipment Assistance given to Weaver artisans by the State Government.

NEW CHARKA/LOOM SCHEME

To inspire the new generation to work In the field of Khadi and to generate the employment, the new Charkha Loom Scheme is in operation through the registered institute of Khadi & Village Industries Commission (Government of India) by Gujarat State Khadi & Village Industries Board. In this Scheme, 65% assistance is given by State Government and 35% Contribution of Price of the Charkha/Loom is borne by the beneficiaries/institutes.

Polyvastra Uniforms Scheme

Two pairs of Polyvastra Uniforms, distributed free of cost to the Students of Government Primary Schools, in the Tehsils selected by the State Government, Scheme is implemented since the year 2016-17. According to that the two pairs of polyvastra Uniforms is distributed for the year 2016-17 and 2017-18 in the following Tehsils.

The Standard of subsidy is categorically 15% to 35% and categorically contribution of loanee is 5% to 10%.
